After staying the first night in San Jose, you will visit the Osa Peninsula, considered one of the most intense ecological sanctuaries in Costa Rica. In this magical place, you can discover the secrets of the rainforest and enjoy the beautiful landscapes of the Golfo Dulce. Later, you will visit the Arenal Volcano, which has erupted regularly since 1969. For the last part of the program, you will visit the Cloud Forest of Los Angeles de San Ramon, where you can enjoy peace and tranquility.

Day 1: Arrive in San Jose, Costa Rica

Arrive at the Juan Santamaría International Airport (SJO); a guide will join you on the drive to the Real Intercontinental Hotel. Located in one of the trendiest areas of San José, Escazu, the Real Intercontinental is surrounded by local businesses, shopping hotspots (including the Multiplaza shopping centre), nightlife and restaurants.

Day 2: Golfo Dulce and the Osa Peninsula

After breakfast, you will be driven to San José town, where a domestic flight to Puerto Jiménez will be waiting for you. From here, you will be transported to the Lapa Rios Ecolodge Hotel: your base for the next three days. Designed in harmony with the environment, the Rios Ecolodge will allow you to experience the feeling of living in the forest, alongside exotic birds, mammals and reptiles—oh, and did we mention the ocean view? Just before dusk, you will embark on a walk in the woods. Alongside a naturalist quide, you will see fascinating nocturnal frogs, spiders, butterflies, snakes and more.

Day 3: Golfo Dulce and the Osa Peninsula

Today, we will hike through the rainforest proper; the Osa Peninsula is considered to have the most biodiversity in the Mesoamerican Pacific region. Pass by enormous trees, cascading waterfalls and endless wildlife, before unwinding back at the hotel.

Day 5: Golfo Dulce – Arenal Volcano

Hop on a morning flight at the Puerto Jiménez airstrip to explore the northern lowlands of Costa Rica. You'll pass over the Talamanca, Central and Tilarán volcanic ranges; the latter of which is home to the Arenal Volcano. You will be staying at the tranquil Arenal Kioro hotel, which is surrounded by beautiful tropical gardens and just steps from the thermal pools.

Day 6: Arenal Volcano

During the morning, you will hike the trails in Arenal Volcano National Park. Experience cooled lava flows, dense rainforest and a huge range of endemic wildlife. If you are lucky, you might even spot a minor eruption from the nearby Arenal Volcano!

Day 7: Arenal Volcano — Los Angeles Cloud Forest

Midmorning, we will drive to the Los Angeles (similar in name, only) Cloud Forest, which is found on the western edge of the Central Volcanic Cordillera. The trip itself offers sweeping views of both rustic villages and rainforest canopy, so remember to look out the window from time to time! Your stay is reserved at the Hotel Villa Blanca, an eco-friendly lodging with traditional Costa Rican style, complete with small fireplaces and local architecture.
